Study Notes for 1 Peter 2:1-12

In the prior two studies, we covered the comprehensiveness of the salvation from eternity past to our future hope. Then Peter turned his attention to the requirements that this salvation with a series of commands that were based on our new reality and had an ultimate purpose in mind. Chapter 2 continues in that vein with some new twists. Study the passage and reflect on the questions below.

4. What would you consider to be the main truth or truths of the passage?
