Study Notes for 1 Peter 3:8-22

We moved from an examination of the greatness of our salvation through to the results, benefits or implications of the new birth through the formation of the new People of God committed to growth, worship, witness, and good deeds. We then looked at the response of resident aliens to civil government, work spaces, and family relationships particularly the husband-wife relationship.
