Galatians 3:1-14 Study Notes

Paul now introduces the main theological discourse in his letter. Here he introduces the great themes contained in the gospel. Paul ends his spiritual autobiography with the centrality of the cross and his identifying with Him and acceptance of His grace. He introduces an indignant tone and then begins to talk about the relevance of Abraham.

1. Note each of the indignant questions that Paul asks. What do they say? How many are there? What kind of tone is being set?
2. Observe what is being said about Abraham. Note key words and phrases and how they are connected.
3. What are your key questions?
4. How would you summarize the key point or truth of the passage?
5. What application would you like to make?
